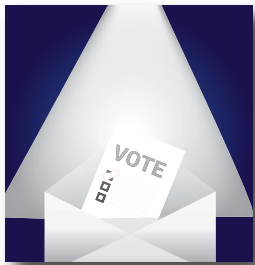

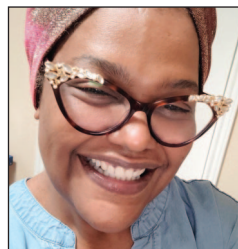

## The Velvet Underground

AN AMERICAN ROCK BAND

Many of you may remember *The Velvet Underground* from the 60s, who *The New York Times* described as “arguably the most influential American rock band of our time.” The fact that they were managed by pop artist Andy Warhol himself surely helped catapult them in their rise to fame, and they were eventually ranked as number 19 on *Rolling Stone*’s list of the “100 Greatest Artists of All Time.” Their music proved to be very influential in the development of punk rock and new wave music.

This November, we celebrate *The Velvet Underground*, and all music that is indie, experimental, and alternative in the mornings at our Velvet Underground Coffee Café.

### Who Was Andy Warhol?

(1928 to 1987)

Some of the art of this renowned American visual artist, film director and producer is included in some of the most expensive paintings ever sold. Warhol was a

leading figure in the visual art movement known as “pop art”, and his work explored the relationship between artistic expression, advertising and celebrity culture that flourished by the 1960s. Some of his best known paintings include the very familiar *Campbell's Soup Cans* (1962), which serve, of course, as the muse for our resident artwork exploration this month. Warhol was often described as the “bellwether of the art market”, and The Andy Warhol Museum in his native city of Pittsburgh is the largest museum in the U.S. dedicated to a single artist.

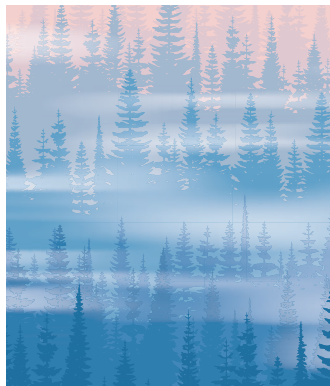

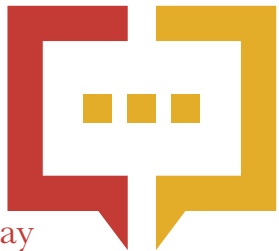

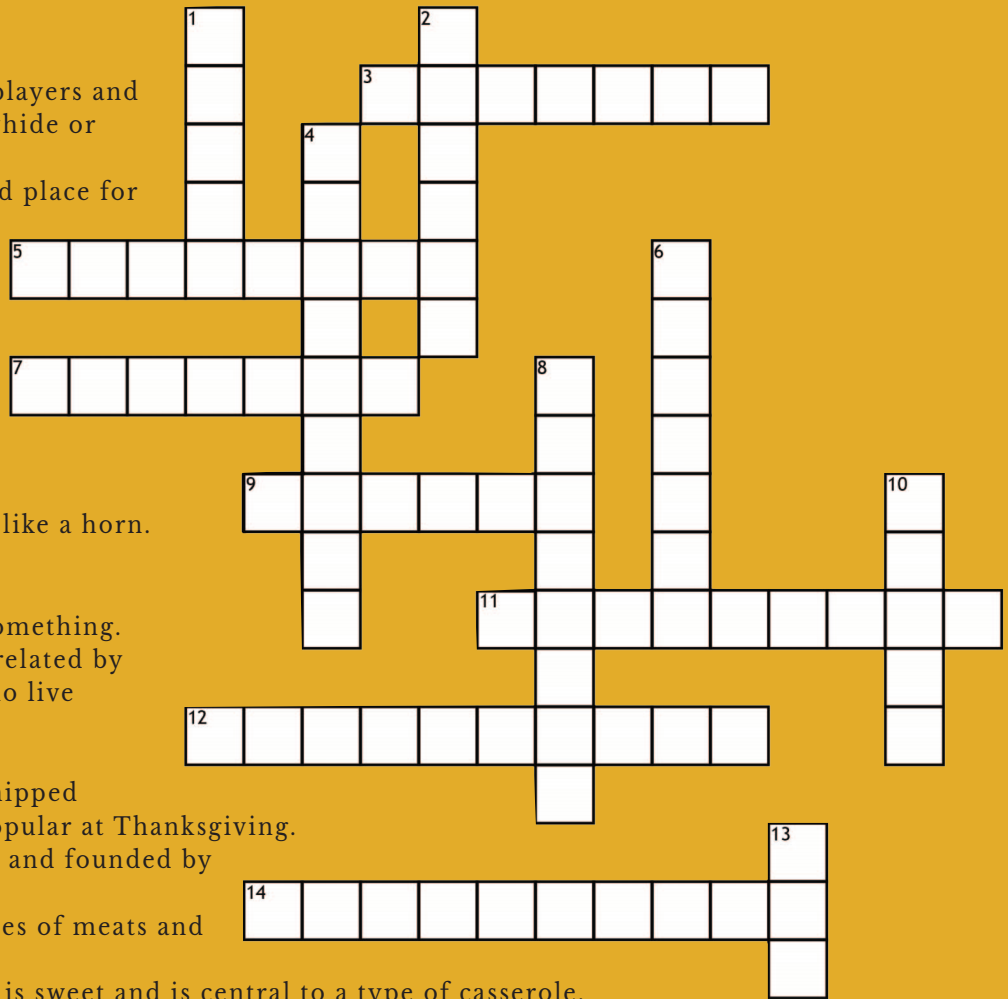
